In 1994 Wyoming.com was conceived to primarily provide dial-up Internet and special circuitry for businesses; these were really the only viable options available at that time. “In 1994, we planned on consumers using 8kbps each”, Benson said, “now, our customers need three or four hundred times that. The really exciting part is that in our twentieth year, we have begun building something that will deliver even more than that.” Benson was referring to the Company’s announcement in February of its Wireless NextGen project for northern Fremont County.

Incorporating the evolution of technology for better services has always been part of the plan.

“Throughout our history, we have continued to roll out new solutions”, Benson stated.

Wyoming.com began delivering high-speed Internet via DSL in 2001 and Wireless Broadband in 2002 as part of the evolution. Wyoming.com also brought digital phone service (“WyoPhone”) to Wyoming in 2007, dedicated ethernet services (“EtherLink”) to businesses in 2007, and MPLS-VPN in 2011. “Being on the leading edge is important to us”, Benson explained. “Our customers appreciate that approach.”

“Our development has created an entity that is able to adapt to our customers’ needs with a full range of products and services”, Robisch added, “and we’re very proud of that ability. Our Company is a true Wyoming brand; born and raised, and still striving for excellence for our neighbors throughout this great state”.

“I’m proud of what we’ve accomplished up to this point, and to do so in Wyoming. However, I know the best is to still to come. We are really are excited about the future”, Benson concluded.
