Wyoming.com Announces New Wireless Tower Partnership with Fremont County Fire Protection District

Riverton, WY (February 26, 2014) – The Wyoming-based Internet Service Provider announced today that it has recently reached a significant property lease agreement for seven new Wireless tower locations in northern Fremont County, Wyoming. The Agreement to install new wireless broadband towers for its new, expanded wireless network – Wireless NextGen - was reached with the Fremont County Fire Protection District and encompasses 1,200 square miles of Fremont County.

The Company announced last week that its Wireless Network for northern Fremont County is in the midst of a major overhaul and expansion. Future announcements relating to the Company's plans to begin the related tower construction will be made at the appropriate times. The lease agreement with the Fremont County Fire Protection District calls for Broadband and WyoPhone services to be provided to specified Fremont County Fire District locations.

"The Fremont County Fire District is pleased to partner with Wyoming.com in this endeavor that will not only benefit the fire service", stated Craig Haslam, District Chief of Fremont County Fire District, "but also our firefighters and the communities that they serve. This partnership will provide services for our firefighters to access training opportunities from web-based training. It will also bring better Internet service to our communities and better access for everyone."

Partnerships with important public service entities have long been important to the Company. "We're all about serving the public interest – directly and indirectly", Mitch Benson, President stated, "and we're honored to partner with Fremont County Fire in a way that's good for both the District and our customers".

Expanding the Company's Wireless Broadband Internet and WyoPhone capabilities through the launch of Wireless NextGen was the driving force for the partnership. "I think our customers, and those who want better Internet and phone service, should be excited about what's coming this year", added Chris Robisch, Director of Sales and Marketing, "We will be pushing Broadband in the rural areas of Wyoming up to a whole new level."
