Riverton, WY (June 21, 2013) – The Wyoming-based Internet Service Provider announced today that it has installed additional equipment on two of its Fremont County towers that provide high-speed Internet services. The upgrade to the Company's facilities was performed to alleviate congestion and allow for additional customers of its Wireless Internet services.

The upgrades were completed for the Kinnear and South Lander towers in May. "Our Wireless Internet customer base continues to grow and we are pleased to announce these tower upgrades for our current and future customers", stated Chris Robisch, Director of Sales and Marketing.

This upgrade activity coincides with a new initiative from the Company to greatly enhance its Wireless network management for our customers. Completion of the updated network management project will naturally lead to the Company's next initiative: Wireless Next Gen. "New Wireless network management enhancements also allow us to design, plan, and, ultimately, build the next great Wireless Internet and voice solution for Wyoming", Robisch stated. "We're excited about what our Wireless Next Gen will provide for the rural customers of Wyoming", Benson said.
